FARM MANAGERS

Once the Farm was established, in collaboration with the Auckland Savings Bank, on 1 May 1933, a position was advertised for an 'Instructor in Agriculture'. It was to be for just 11 hours per week. It attracted a young graduate with excellent credentials, Mr F. Sydenham, MAgSc, who was appointed a part-time Master. He left at the end of the year. In 1934 Mr A.J. Gibson was appointed a full-time Master. (He remained for many years). At the same time Mr W.S. Fleming was appointed a part-time Farm Manager. When Mr Fleming left to take up a more lucrative position in Tasmania, there was an interregnum filled by the young Mr R.V. Corin from 15 April 1934 -17 May 1934.
