From the Headmaster

A Safe School is a Vaccinated School



Tēnā koutou, e te whānau o Mount Albert Grammar School.

On Tuesday, more than 1400 students and 200 staff returned to MAGS in person as we took the first steps to restarting on-site learning at our school.

Over recent days, the display of confidence from our community has been impressive

and has endorsed the desire to reconnect in person with friends and colleagues.

Safety is paramount at the moment as we follow health advice around mask wearing, physical distancing and ventilation of classrooms. These measures are complemented by expectations that **100%** of staff, students and other on-site adults are all working towards being fully vaccinated.

Our vaccination statistics to date are encouraging, with **92%** of staff being fully vaccinated (**95%** first dose). And our Student Vaccination Register is currently showing an impressive **97%** of student respondents to date as fully vaccinated.

As we move towards our 100% vaccination target, we can look forward to making the most of the term ahead in the knowledge we have a safe and supportive school setting. Thank you to all who helped with the revival this week!

Year 10 subject choices in 2022

Students who will be Year 10s in 2022 need to make their option choices via <u>SchoolPoint</u> by next Friday, November 5.

1. Will automatically be enrolled for English, Maths, Science, Social Studies and Physical Education.

2. Need to then make up to four option choices from the combination of courses on offer within Table A, Table B and Table C.

It is important for students to check with Mentors to make sure they have made the right number of choice combinations to equate to eight lessons per week.
