

International Student Fees 2023

Course Fees:

Tuition Fees: NZ\$ 18,500 per year (shorter periods on application)

Administration Fee:NZ\$ 1,500 per year (pro-rata)Government Levy Fees:NZ\$ 429 per year (pro-rata)

NCEA Qualification Fee: NZ\$ 385 per year (Usually Years 11-13 only)

Accommodation Fees:

Homestay

Terms 1 & 2 NZ\$ 8,320 (\$320 p.w. – 26 weeks)
Terms 3 & 4 NZ\$ 7,680 (\$320 p.w. – 24 weeks)

Full Year NZ\$ 15,360 per year (\$320 p.w. – 48 weeks)

Note: an additional Homesay fee will be required for students staying in NZ over the December/ January holidays

For special dietary requirements add NZ\$20 per week

Accommodation Monitoring Fee (per placement) NZ\$350

Any overpayment of homestay fees will be refunded at the end of the student's schooling.

Insurance: NZ\$616 per year

Insurance is compulsory under Immigration NZ regulations. The School recommends the Uni-Care NZ Student Plan (see www.uni-care.org) other policies must comply with the New Zealand regulations

Additional Fees:

Airport Transfer on Arrival \$69

School uniform approximately \$480 – purchased by the student on arrival at the school

Co - curricular activities some costs may apply

Refunds:

The school will consider all requests for a refund of international student fees. There is no refund of hostel fees expect in exceptional circumstances. (See refund policy on the school website)

Orientation

The International Office runs an orientation programme for all new students on their arrival. Each student will receive orientation information about Auckland, daily life in New Zealand, school life and regulations.

Uniform

The uniform shop is located on the school grounds. You can purchase all uniform items excluding school shoes and bags.

Homestay

All of our homestay families are within a 15-20 minute bus ride from school. Transport to school is usually by walking/cycling/bus/car. If by bus, the student will pay their own bus-fare.

Bring your own device

Students at Mount Albert Grammar School are required to bring a personal computing device for use in class to support their learning.

The school has reviewed which devices are best suited for our students' needs and they may bring either a MacBook, a Windows laptop, an iPad with a keyboard or a Chromebook as their digital learning device. Smartphones are not considered as a suitable main device in the BYOD programme.

Calculator

A Scientific Calculator is required in Year 9 and Year 10

For Years 11-13, a Graphics Calculator is recommended but not compulsory. (Maths only compulsory at Year 11)



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
