What is the MCEA? MCEA stands for <u>MAGS Certificate of Educational A</u>chievement. This is the first key year of working towards a qualification in the NZQA Framework. In Year 10 students had the opportunity to gain credits in the NCEA co-requisite Numeracy & Literacy assessments (these can be re-attempted in Year 11-13). In Year 11 all students take 3 subjects from the compulsory subjects column below & they have already chosen their 3 from the optional subjects.

A key aim of the Year 11 course is to build a solid foundation of content knowledge required for success at NCEA Level 2 in 2026. All subjects have ongoing assessments across the year. All assessments are rigorous & will test a full range of the knowledge & skills required to do well in each subject. Each subject/course is worth 20 credits (across 6 subjects students will be enrolled in 120 credits.) Of these 20 credits, each subject will offer at least 5 'NCEA' Level 1 credits, & the remaining are MAGS MCEA credits or additional NCEA credits. Each student has the opportunity to attain at least 30 NCEA Level 1 credits for each subject may be internals or externals. The NCEA credits for each subject may be internals or externals. The Term 3 MAGS school exams will be an opportunity to practice for the Term 4 external NCEA exams. They can also be used as evidence for derived grades for the NCEA externals.
