Safety at School

MAGS, for the safety, well-being and education of the student, expects the parent to agree to

- 1. MAGS staff taking action on behalf of the parent in cases of emergency
- 2. being responsible for the cost of any such action (such as ambulance fees.)
- 3. the student participating in the co-curricular activities offered by the school;
- 4. the student participating in Education Outside the Classroom
- 5. allowing the student to be walked or transported off the school campus under the jurisdiction of a member of staff, a coach, or another parent for the purpose of a school activity.
- 6. permitting the school nurse, when necessary, to treat the student appropriately and to administer non-prescription medicines such as paracetamol, antihistamine, throat lozenges as deemed necessary.
- 7. permitting the school nurse to arrange for the student to be taken to Accident and Emergency, doctor or physiotherapist in the event the parents cannot be contacted.
