

There are prerequisites that must be met to gain entry into most courses for NCEA and you will find information about any pre-requisites in the course information.






2. Let us know whether you are returning next year

If it doesn't automatically ask you for this information you can

- select Profile and then 'Leaving Destination'
- then select your destination and click 'Continue'





Begin to explore your choices:

- Courses for Me courses that you are eligible to choose given your year group
- My courses your list of courses once you start making selections
- Faculties all courses available (but you may not be able to select them)
- Course favourites courses that you have selected as a favourite to consider

What do the codes mean?

S = Scholarship course

A or E = Accelerate or Enriched course (*A course with standards above the year group*)

1 = A course which meets the requirements of endorsement (14 or more credits with a mixture of External and Internal credits)

2 = A course which meets the minimum requirements of endorsement (*There may only be one External standard so less opportunity to achieve endorsement*)

3 = A course which does NOT meet the requirements of endorsement (*Likely to be all Internal standards – Best for students who work best with Internal Assessment*)

4 = A course which has only Unit standards (Usually Vocational Focus)



- 4. You may be directed to make some choices first.
- Year 11 2020 (current Year 10) must choose one English and one Maths course first
- Year 12 2020 (current Year 11) must choose one English. They may also need to choose Maths if they still need Numeracy
- Year 13 2020 (current Year 12) are not required to choose any particular subject but may need to choose English if they don't have UE Literacy and plan to go to University



It is possible to request a special exemption (**Request**

Exemption), but it is advisable to speak to the teacher in charge first.

This request will not count as one of your main choices. You will still need to make your 5 or 6 other choices.



- 7. Backup choices (In case you don't meet the prerequisites)
- You can also select Backup courses on top of your 5 or 6 main courses (but you do not have to have backups)
- Current Year 10 and Year 11 pupils can choose up to 2 backups
- Current Year 12 pupils can choose up to 6 backups. Some Scholarship courses can only be chosen as a Backup but the department will still review your expression of interest in studying this course at Scholarship Level.





8. Once you have made all your choices check your total credits is above 80 for Year 11 course and above 60 for Year 12/13 courses.

- You can remove a subject and change to a new subject if you change your mind.
