- 1. CLASHES.** You will receive an email from Miss Rose about any clashes that we already know about and you must follow the instructions within the email. If you do not receive an email by **Sunday 17th August** and find that you have a clash, then **you must complete the form at the student centre.**
Students who are contacted about a clash, **MUST adhere to the changes communicated.**
- 2. SPECIAL ASSESSMENT CONDITIONS:** If you sit assessments with special conditions eg; you have a reader writer or have extra time, please complete the online booking form for SAC. **Ms Laing will send you a separate booking form just for these exams to make it easier.**
- 3. Punctuality:** Check your exam timetable carefully to ensure you know where you must be. Note: it takes time at the beginning to set up and at the end to collect papers.
AM: Arrive by 8.20am for morning exams to start at 8.45AM – MON, TUES, WED, FRI.
(NB: THURSDAY Exam times are the same as the rest of the week, regardless of usual late start)
PM: Arrive by 12.45pm for afternoon exams to start at 1.10pm.

NOTE: Afternoon exams are scheduled to finish at 4.10pm, so this may affect your usual travel/transport arrangements.
THURSDAY exam times are CLEARLY indicated on the exam timetable

- 4. Late to an exam – Don't be late!** If you are late for an examination, you must get a late note. You will not be allowed to enter until you have done so. Try to catch an earlier bus/train than usual, just to be sure.
- 5. Rooms:** Lists of rooms for examinations are posted each day in the Year level Google Classroom and on notice boards outside the Old Library and Student Centre, MH Block, and other areas around the school. You must arrive early enough to read these and make your way to the correct venue. Be there, ready to start, **AT LEAST 25 mins** before the start time.
- 5. Talking:** There is **no talking** once an examination has commenced. **Eating:** No eating or chewing gum is permitted. You may bring water.
- 6. No dictionaries or translation aids,** electronic or otherwise, are allowed in most examinations. All **calculators** must have any programmable memory cleared. **(NZQA). Cellphones** and **watches** are permitted **if turned off** and in a transparent plastic bag on the floor. **(NZQA)**
- 7. Bags** are to be left at the FRONT or BACK of the examination room/hall. **PENCIL CASES ARE NOT PERMITTED (NZQA).** Students must carry equipment in a transparent plastic bag **(NZQA).** **DO NOT bring your school bag unless you have to.**
- 8. Uniform:** Students will **NOT** be admitted to an examination in incorrect uniform. **NOTE: You are not permitted at St Lukes in school uniform** during the exam period.
- 9. Leaving early from Exams:** You are NOT to leave an examination other than through illness or an URGENT toilet request, and a staff member must accompany you. **You may NOT leave an examination early if you have finished.**
- 10. Exam Leave: Senior students - Years 11, 12, 13** - only come to school to sit an examination, or with the WRITTEN permission/instruction of a staff member for tutorial or study purposes. At all other times they must be **at home studying or in designated study rooms**, as provided on the exam room lists.
- 11. Exam Leave: Year 11, 12 & 13** only attend school to sit an examination, or attend tutorials and workshops or study purposes. At all other times they must be **at home studying.**
- 12. Exam Leave: Students in other year groups** who are taking a Level 1, 2 or 3 course for which there is an exam may have study leave for the morning of an afternoon exam. All other classes must be attended.
- 13. Absence from Exams:** If you do not sit an examination(s) without good cause (e.g.: medical certificate) you will receive 'Not Achieved' and this will be recorded on your results. **SITTING school EXAMS is critical should you need to get derived grades for NCEA exams at the end of the year.** Derived grades are not available for Scholarship exams. In the event you miss an exam, contact your dean who will make arrangements for you to sit the exam at an alternative time.
- 14. TUTORIALS** – provision has been made for practical courses to complete ongoing assessment. Make sure you take full advantage of these.

These examinations test you under the same conditions as NZQA exams that are run at the end of the year
