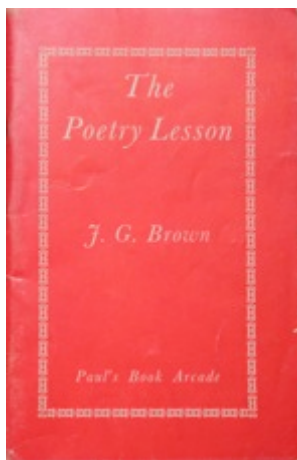

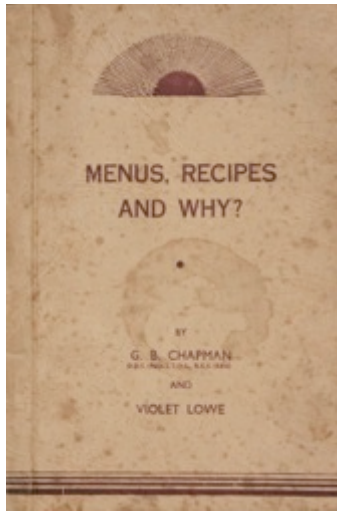

4. *Menus, Recipes and Why?* by GB Chapman and Violet Lowe published by Burnock Publications (Auckland) 1939. A booklet of 88pp (11 signatures), perfect binding. 7 in x 5 in / 180 mm x 130 mm. This booklet likely grew out of the use of Dr Chapman's work with introducing his dietary regimen at School House in 1937.

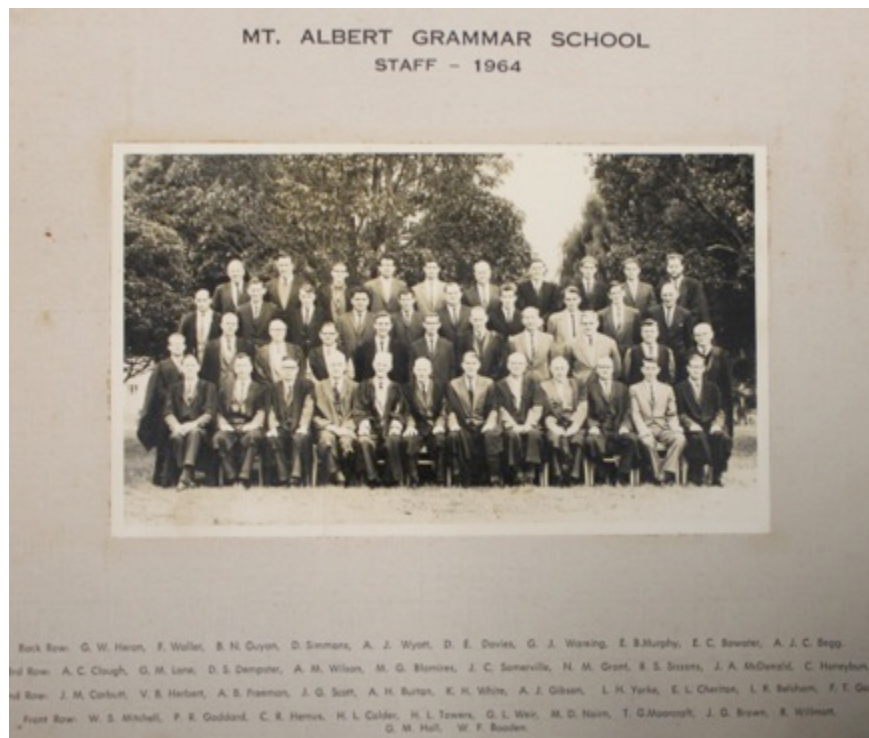
