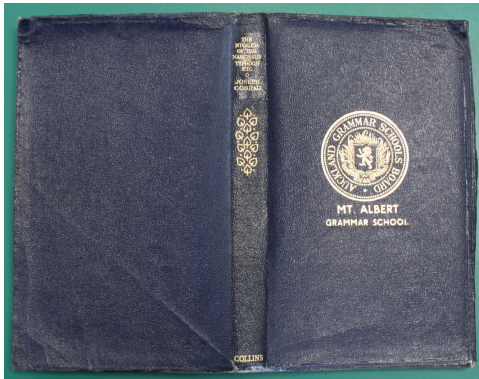

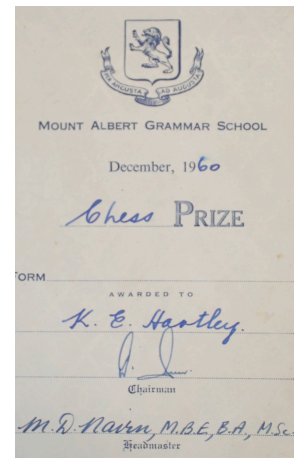


A prize book

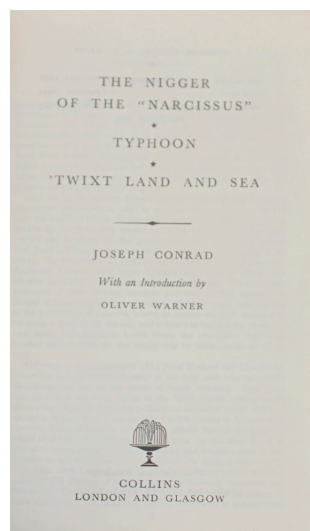
The book cover bears the gold-embossed common seal of the Auckland Grammar School Board and the name of the school.

The prize plate shows the 1960 Chess Prize awarded to KE Heartley and signed by D (David) Sumner, Chairman and Headmaster Murray Nairn who always signed himself in a full legible hand, and with punctilious attention to punctuation:

M.D. Nairn, M.B.E., B.A., M.Sc.



The book is a series of five tales of the sea by Joseph Conrad written between 1898 and 1923. This edition is published by Collins, London and Glasgow, 1955, 386pp.



The book is 7 ¼ in x 4 ½ in / 185mm x 115 mm and is in fair condition, the cover, at the back, is partially detached and the overall cover is a little out of shape. The pages are in good condition.
