1. **STUDENT EXAM TIMETABLE - READ IT, AND ALL THE INFORMATION BELOW!**
2. **NOTE: CLASHES. ALL practical or aural exams must be completed in the set time slot, and the written exam is re-scheduled. STUDENTS are to go to Student Centre Office ASAP to arrange re-schedule one of the exams. DO THIS ASAP!**
3. **PUNCTUALITY:** Check your daily timetables carefully to ensure you know where you have to be at all times. Punctuality is critical.

AM EXAMS = Be at school ready for AM exams by 8.20am, to be in room/hall. Morning exams start at 8.45am
PM EXAMS = Be at school ready for PM exams by 12.45pm, to be in room/hall. Afternoon exams start at 1.10pm.

NOTE: Afternoon exams are scheduled to finish at 4.10pm, so this may affect your usual travel/transport arrangements.
THURSDAY exam times are **CLEARLY** indicated on the exam timetable

4. **Rooms:** Lists of rooms for examinations are posted each day on white boards and notice boards outside the back of the Hall, at the Library and Student Centre, A Block & P7. You must arrive early enough to read these and make your way to the correct venue. Be there, ready to start, **AT LEAST 25 mins** before the start time.
5. **Talking:** There is **no talking** once an examination has commenced. **Eating:** No eating or chewing gum is permitted.
6. **No dictionaries or translation aids**, electronic or otherwise, are allowed in examinations. All **calculators** must have any programmable memory cleared. (NZQA). **Cellphones** are permitted **if turned off** and in a transparent plastic bag on the floor. (NZQA)
7. **Bags** are to be left at the FRONT or BACK of the examination room/hall. **PENCIL CASES ARE NOT PERMITTED (NZQA)**. Students must carry equipment in a transparent plastic bag (NZQA). **DO NOT bring your school bag unless you have to (Ms WLM)**.
8. **Late:** Students who are late for an examination must get a late note from a Senior Manager first. They will not be allowed to enter until they have done so. Plan to catch an earlier bus/train than usual, just to be sure.
9. **Uniform:** Students will **NOT** be admitted to an examination in incorrect **uniform**.
NOTE: Students are not permitted at St Lukes in school uniform.
10. **Special Exam conditions:** If you are a student who sits examinations under special conditions eg; use a reader writer or have extra time, or use an electronic device - **make sure you speak to Mr Tashmeer or Mrs Drake, in the Learning Support Dept, to confirm your arrangements.**
11. **Leaving Exams:** Students are **NOT** to leave an examination other than through illness or an **URGENT toilet** request.
12. **REPEAT: Students may NOT leave an examination early.**
13. **Exam Leave:** Senior students - Years 11, 12, 13 - only come to school to sit an examination, or with the WRITTEN permission/instruction of a staff member for tutorial or study purposes. At all other times they must be **at home studying or in designated study rooms**, as provided on the exam room lists. **SCHOLARSHIP students have EXTENDED leave** granted as required to sit their SCHOLARSHIP EXAMS.
14. **Absence from Exams:** Students who do not sit examinations without good cause (e.g: medical certificate) will receive 'Not Achieved' and this will be recorded on their reports.
15. **ATTENDANCE at exams** is critical in the event that you are prevented from sitting your NZQA exams at the end of the year. Your school exam results are used to provide you with a **derived grade**. You owe it to yourself to prepare, attend and do your best.
16. **INTERNAL ASSESSMENTS** – provision has been made for some internal assessments/checkpoints. Make sure you take full advantage of these and check with your teachers regarding any special requirements, times etc.

SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATES NOTE:

- **ONLY CALC & STATS** are scheduled separately due to numbers; and French, German, Japanese because of the aural component.
- **BOOK OTHER SCHOLARSHIP exams** on the mornings of WED 20th, THU 21st, FRI 22nd & MON 25th at the Student Centre. (maybe TUES 26th)

There are four opportunities offered to accommodate those sitting multiple SCHOLARSHIP SUBJECTS, outside of the timetables options. You may sit your practice SCHOLARSHIP exams in the order of your choosing. **NOTE: the scholarship exam flexibility is offered because the exams are more frequent than is the norm during NZQA exams, due to NZQA exams being over a longer period of time.**

YOU MUST BOOK & TURN UP – NO ONE WILL REMIND YOU!

These examinations provide the opportunity for you to test yourself under the conditions that NZQA exams are run at the end of the year. **TAKE THEM SERIOUSLY!** The marks you achieve in these WILL BE used later should unforeseen circumstances require you to need derived grade(s).
