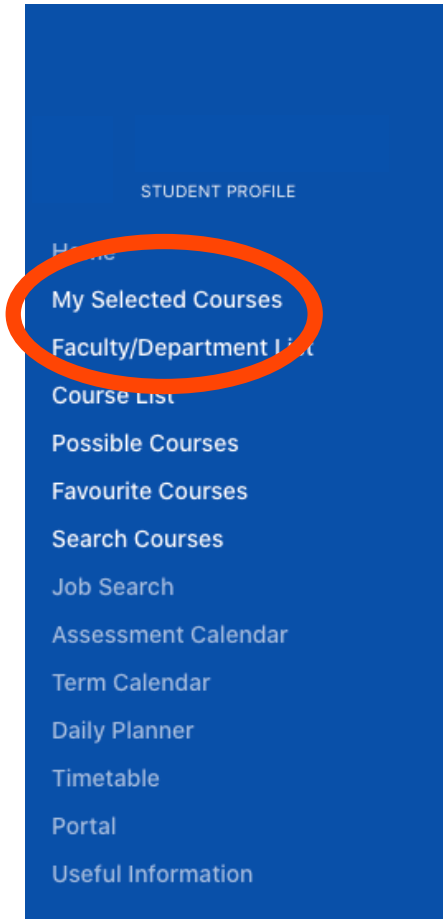


7. Students are given the chance to choose some Backup options, but DO NOT have to complete these and DO NOT have to fill them all.

- Year 10 can choose 2 backups
- Year 11 can choose 2 backups
- Year 12 can choose up to 6 backups BUT DO NOT need to fill all 6 spaces.

The one period Scholarship courses can only be chosen as a backup which is why Year 12 have so many backup options.
