- 1. STUDENT EXAM TIMETABLE READ IT, AND ALL THE INFORMATION BELOW!
- 2. NOTE: CLASHES. Students will be contacted via school email and through your AMP mentor about known clashes and should adhere to the proposed time

<u>ALL practical or aural exams</u> must be completed in the set time slot. Written exams will be rescheduled for the next available time slot If you have not been contacted about an exam clash, but there is a problem YOU are to go to contact Mr Barrett <u>pbarrett@mags.school.nz</u> as soon as possible to arrange re-scheduling one of the exams.

- PUNCTUALITY: Check your daily timetables carefully to ensure you know where you have to be at all times. Punctuality is critical. AM EXAMS = Be at school ready for AM exams by 8.20am, to be in room/hall. Morning exams <u>start</u> at 8.45am PM EXAMS = Be at school ready for PM exams by 12.45pm, to be in room/hall. Afternoon exams <u>start</u> at 1.10pm. NOTE: Afternoon exams are scheduled to finish at 4.10pm, so this may affect your usual travel/transport arrangements. THURSDAY exam times are CLEARLY indicated on the exam timetable
- 4. Rooms: Lists of rooms for examinations are posted each day on white boards and notice boards outside the back of the Hall, at the Library and Student Centre, MH Block, A BLOCK & P7. You must arrive early enough to read these and make your way to the correct venue. Be there, ready to start, <u>AT LEAST 25 mins</u> before the start time.
- 5. Talking: There is no talking once an examination has commenced.
- 6. Eating: No eating or chewing gum is permitted. Small amount of bottled water is permissible.
- 6. No dictionaries or translation aids, electronic or otherwise, are allowed in most examinations. All calculators must have any programmable memory cleared. (NZQA). Cellphones and watches are permitted <u>if turned off</u> and in a transparent plastic bag on the floor. (NZQA)
- 7. Bags are to be left at the FRONT or BACK of the examination room/hall. PENCIL CASES ARE NOT PERMITTED (NZQA). Students must carry equipment in a transparent plastic bag (NZQA). DO NOT bring your school bag unless you have to.
- 8. Late: Students who are late for an examination must get a late note from a Senior Manager first. They will not be allowed to enter until they have done so. Plan to catch an earlier bus/train than usual, just to be sure.
- 9. Uniform: Students will NOT be admitted to an examination in incorrect uniform. NOTE: You are not permitted at St Luke's in school uniform.
- 10. Special Exam conditions: If you are a student who sits examinations under special conditions e.g.; use a reader writer or have extra time, or use an electronic device make sure you speak to Mrs Henwood or Mrs Drake, in the Learning Support Dept, to confirm your arrangements.
- 11. Leaving Exams: Students are NOT to leave an examination early other than through illness or an <u>URGENT toilet</u> request. <u>REPEAT: Students may NOT leave an examination early.</u>
- 12. Exam Leave: Senior students Years 11, 12, 13 only come to school to sit an examination, or with the WRITTEN permission/instruction of a staff member for tutorial or study purposes. At all other times they must be at home studying or in the designated study rooms, as provided on the exam room lists.
- **13.** Absence from Exams: Students who do not sit examinations <u>without good cause</u> (e.g. medical certificate) will receive 'Not Achieved' and this will be recorded on their reports. You should contact your dean and make arrangements to sit the exam you missed within the exam period.
- 14. ATTENDANCE at exams is critical in the event that you are prevented from sitting your NZQA exams at the end of the year. Your school exam results are used to provide you with a **derived grade** and will be used as a **pre-requisite** for your entry into next year's courses.

These examinations provide the opportunity for you to test yourself under the conditions that NZQA exams are run at the end of the year. TAKE THEM SERIOUSLY! The marks you achieve in these WILL BE used as pre-requisites for entry into courses in 2021 and may also be used later should unforeseen circumstances require you to need derived grade(s).

## SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATES NOTE:

Students who wish to sit one or more of the Scholarship exams will be able to do so during the first week of the end of term Holiday. The available sessions are between Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September through to Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October morning and afternoon. You will be able to indicate your preference for an exam slot through a Google Form document.

Students who do not sit the practice Scholarship exams will still be allowed to sit the final Scholarship exams at the end of the Year.
