



Assessment Calendar


1. Go to the MAGS website and select 'SchoolPoint' from the Student Portal.



2. Select 'Login' at the top right of the screen and enter your KAMAR username and Password. These have been sent to you in the email.



3. From the Home page you can select
 - Assessment Calendar
 - Term Calendar
 - Daily Planner




4. The **'Term Calendar'** is the easiest way to see, at a glance, when Assessments are due or taking place. Assessments may be published with a specific final date or they may be published over a period of time if it is an assessment over a number of days.


The colour represents the Assessment type: Assessment, Assignment, Checkpoint, Performance, Test, Practical, Portfolio/Project.

When you click on the Assessment it will show you the standard number, course and title of the standard. It also states what type of Assessment it is.



5. In **'Term Calendar'** mode you can turn on or off various terms. Click on the *cog symbol* at the top of the screen.

The terms that are turned on are blue
Terms that are turned off are not blue



6. 'Assessment Calendar' takes you to the daily breakdown of the Calendar with the Authenticity and Plagiarism statements at the top. In this view you can see if the task is over more than one day and see the specific due date if it is a one-day Assessment. Again, the colour matches the type of assessment.



8. The saved note will show on the day set in the **'Assessment Calendar'** and will then show in your own personal **'Daily Planner'**. You can also set up reminders for a specific date to show in your **'Daily Planner'**.

This is an active Calendar and can be updated as needed by your teachers. It is not advisable to print or sync this calendar as you may miss out on any changes.
