- If a student wishes to choose Art for the whole year, they should choose BOTH 10AR1 AND 10AR2

It may take some time to get a response to this request so please complete your other options.

Possible reasons:

1. If you are not studying a prior course required for automatic selection
2. If you are not in the current year to be able to select the course.
